## Five-Station Prayer Guide

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens — Jesus the Son of God — let us hold fast to our confession. 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who has been tempted in every way as we are, yet without sin. 16 Therefore, let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in time of need. Hebrews 4:14-16

### Station #1—Confessing

If we say, “We have no sin,” we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10 If we say, “We have not sinned,” we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. 1 John 1:8-10

Sin is any attitude or action contrary to the Word of God. Sin breaks our fellowship with God and others.

Self-examination questions to consider:

- Is there any hidden or unconfessed sin in my life?
- Is there any unforgiveness or bitterness in my life?
- Have I ignored any clear commands or callings from God?

Spend time asking God to reveal unknown sin, and confessing all known and revealed sin. Repent and return to the Lord.

### Station #2—Loving

This is why, since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, 16 I never stop giving thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. 17 I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, would give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him. 18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened so that you may know what is the hope of his calling, what is the wealth of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the mighty working of his strength. Ephesians 1:15-19

Jesus prayed for his disciples. The apostle Paul prayed for his fellow believers. Because we love one another, we pray for one another.

Prayer prompts:

- Who is sick? Who is hurting? Who is struggling in their marriage or family? Who is experiencing financial hardship? Who is walking away from Jesus? Who is a new believer? Who is returning to Jesus after a time of rebellion? Who is leading? Who are your pastors and deacons? Who are serving your children or grandchildren?

Pray Ephesians 1:15-19 over these friends, family, neighbors, and fellow church members.

### Station #3—Looking

“My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work,” Jesus told them. 35 “Don’t you say, ‘There are still four more months, and then comes the harvest’? Listen to what I’m telling you: Open your eyes and look at the fields, because they are ready for harvest. 36 The reaper is already receiving pay and gathering fruit for eternal life, so that the sower and reaper can rejoice together. 37 For in this case the saying is true: ‘One sows and another reaps.’ 38 I sent you to reap what you didn’t labor for; others have labored, and you have benefited from their labor.” John 4:34-38

Jesus called his followers to look up and see the harvest of souls already prepared.

Prayer prompts:

- 80% of our city's residents are not faithfully connected to the mission of Jesus loving church. That means about 25,000 people either need to turn to Jesus or return to Jesus.
- 1% of our city is about 325 people. Can Green Hill Church reach 1% of our city for Jesus in the next 3 years?
- Who's in your circle: Neighbors? Co-workers? Classmates? Teammates? Business owners? Healthcare providers? Restaurant waiters/waitresses? Etc.
- Local schools: We're working to establish 5 school partnerships over the next 3 years.
- Who have you had a Gospel Conversation with in the last month? Who will you speak with this week?

## Station #4—Reaching

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” Acts 1:8

- Trey and Jordan Van Camp—Passion Creek Church, Phoenix, Arizona
- Jeff and Cathy Postell—Outreach to Egyptians—Nashville

Possible New Partnerships

- Middle East Outreach in Gaza
- Wael and Odette Sous—Arabic Ministry, Mt. Juliet
- In Nashville Metro, there are 1.5 million unchurched; 95 people groups; 140 languages.
- There are 7000 unreached people groups in the world representing approximately 3 billion people.

Pray for God to raise up missionaries and church planters to reach the world for Christ, and for Green Hill Church to become a sending church to the nations.

## Station #5—Praising

Now to him who is able to protect you from stumbling and to make you stand in the presence of his glory, without blemish and with great joy, 25 to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, power, and authority before all time, now and forever. Amen. Jude 1:24-25

Jesus is worthy of our worship.

Prayer prompts:

- When did Jesus save you? Spend a moment praising him for giving you new and eternal life.
- How has God revealed himself to you recently? Who has he put in your life to encourage you and help you walk with him? How have you grown in his Word this month?
- Use the Post-It notes to record recent victories won, answers given, or people saved or restored. Place the note on or at the foot of the cross as an act of worship.
